Consistent with the Port of Olympia Commission's scheduling of its regular meetings from time to time in locations throughout Thurston County, the May 14th Commission meeting will be held in Tenino. The meeting will begin at 5:30 p.m. in the Commons at Tenino High School, 500 West 2nd Avenue.

The meeting agenda will include various standing Port business items for Commission consideration and staff briefings. Included in the briefings will be a report on the exploration of a possible joint project between the Port of Olympia and the Port of Tacoma to create what is being called the South Sound Logistics Center on about 745 acres located in the Maytown area.
