MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING**

**April 6, 2006**

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**CALL TO ORDER**

President Pottle via teleconference called the meeting of April 6, 2006, to order at 4:45 p.m. at the Port Administrative Office. Commissioners Telford and Van Schoorl were also in attendance.

Staff in attendance were: Executive Director Ed Galligan, Marine Terminal Director Jim Amador, and Marketing Director Kari Qvigstad. Legal counsel in attendance included Bob Goodstein and Carolyn Lake.

The Commission adjourned to Executive Session to review the recent public records decision by Judge Hicks at 4:46 p.m.

After discussion amongst all three Commissioners, President Pottle by phone, the Commissioners re-convened into public session at 5:25 PM at which time President Pottle had to hang up before conclusion of the executive session. Vice President Telford then presided, closed the executive session and convened an open public meeting in which Commissioner Telford and Van Schoorl voted to direct the Port Director to work with staff to file a request for reconsideration, limiting the request to only specific documents for which a clear exemptions apply. The Commissioners emphasized that the request was not a challenge of Judge Hick's decision. The Motion passed by a Commission vote of 2-0.
