Second place was awarded to Vern's Restaurant in Shelton, and the third place prize went to the Riverbend Restaurant at Hawks Prairie Casino. Fire Creek Ale House also won the Chefs' Choice award, voted on by participating restaurants, and Anthony's HomePort was awarded the prize for the best decorated booth.

Other outstanding restaurants competing this year included Ben Moore's, Budd Bay Café, Luna's Deli, Lucky Eagle Casino, Red Lion Hotel, Red Wind Casino, and South Puget Sound Community College Culinary Arts. The Chowder Challenge was just one part of this annual waterfront festival. Over 75 vendors at the BoatSwap sold new and used boats and gear. Entertainment, including live music provided by the rock band Raucous as well as other family fun were featured all day.
